- Corrections North (Warren County-based facilities) Mark B > No report.
  - Lebanon Correctional Institution (LECI) MONDAY nights, Rex S is the AA member and volunteer coordinator; THURSDAY nights at 7:30pm, Mark is the AA member and volunteer coordinator, accompanied by Dan L.
  - Warren Correctional Institution (WCI) Now open for AA volunteers; the meeting is on Tuesday nights and applications are required.

- Turtle Creek Center (TCC) operated by Talbert House We heard from Beau O, one of the anchor-volunteers there, that they are now open and Beau will be going in every other Sunday night.
- Community Correctional Center (CCC) operated by Talbert House It does not sound like they are open to outside volunteers yet.
- Warren County Jail (WCJ) Open to AA volunteers. MEN covered by Mark and Dan on Saturday mornings. WOMEN have no current AA member volunteer or meeting; Mark has been looking for women volunteers; volunteers who can pass the background check / application process and are <u>committed</u> to regularly attending are needed to hopefully restart this service.
- Corrections South (Clermont County-based facilities) Bryan B > Reports...
  - Clermont County Jail (CCJ) Open to AA volunteers.
    - MEN: Bryan coordinates Monday night Room 253; Michael C has coordinated Monday night Room 686, but will need to vacate; Pat C will remain; Rick B coordinates Wednesday morning Room 253. Scott T has expressed in interest in attending jail meetings; contact information of the current volunteer coordinators was provided to him.
    - WOMEN: Wednesday night meeting in Room 686, Sara S is the contact person.
  - Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CASC) Still open to AA volunteers. MEN: Ron D coordinates the Monday nights. WOMEN: Sally P coordinates these.
- Mercy Clermont Behavioral Health Institute Patti J > Reports...
